Dear students,

It is our pleasure to announce the I.I.T.J.E.E (2017) training program for the standard XI students. For the batch of 2015-17 we have already selected 56 students from our Mathematics Foundation Program. In order to cater to other deserving students, we are happy to announce another batch of fresh students.

All students scoring at least 50 percent marks in our entrance test will be selected.

Here are some of the most common questions that students ask us. We have given reasonably complete answers to these questions. **Carefully read** each and every word of the information given below. This will help you to take a decision that is most suitable to you.

What about Std XI and XII syllabus?

IIT JEE syllabus covers much more than syllabii of HSC, ICSE and CBSE boards. So training for IIT automatically covers all these syllabuses. Our training program is designed keeping JEE Advanced examination in mind, so the emphasis will be on complete understanding of the concepts and IIT level problem solving. Ours is actually **IITJEE⁺⁺** training program. We teach all the proofs of the results required for the examination. Our students not only do well at IIT-JEE but continue to do exceptionally well after joining IIT.

What is schedule/time-table of this course?

Our training program will start from 11th May 2015.

There will be regular practice tests once every month in the Std XI.

There will be regular practice tests twice every month in the Std XII.

After the XII board exam is over, several mock tests will be conducted.

The only holidays will be one week at the time of Diwali and summer vacation for 10 days.

Suggest the name of the best possible college.

In Pune city, XI admissions are done through a centralised admission process. Several colleges are available. Senior students studying in our academy give detailed tips about which college to join, etc.

All you need to do is choose a college so that there is no clash of timetable.

How much hard work is expected from me?

We first estimate the time required for non academic activities.

Activity	Time Required
Sleeping	7 Hours
Eating	1 Hour
Commuting between home and college	0.5 Hours
Commuting between home and MPA	0.5 Hours
Physical Fitness	1 Hour
Hobby	1 Hour
Socialising	1 Hour
Total	12 Hours

So note that having accounted for all the non academic activities, you have **12 Hours** every day at your disposal for academic activities. Now if you are really serious about joining IIT we expect that you actually use **each minute** of these twelve hours for the purpose of studying. This includes college hours as well as time spent at our institute. The more time you are able to study independently, better will be your chances of getting in IIT. That is why choosing a college where you need to spend minimum amount of time is the best choice. Typically in the vacation period you should be studying for three hours for each subject at home, and attend the lectures at the academy for a period of three hours.

Respected Parents, we want you to make this requirement of putting in **12 Hours of Study Every day for next two years** absolutely clear to your ward. If he does well in our entrance test we are sure of his intellectual ability to grasp what we will teach him. But you know better about his true ability of doing focused work for two years. We do not have any magic wands. At all India level there is fierce competition for getting into IIT. 5 lakhs of student write the exam and only 10000 get through. That is only 2% of students actually make it. With our training we can improve his chances from 2% to more than 40%. The major reason we believe why remaining students don't make it is they simply do not work hard enough. We **request** the parents not to enroll their ward in our academy if their son/daughter does not possess this hardworking ability. Instead of accepting lazy students, we do not mind a student of a lower rank in our merit list who is actually capable of putting all the hard work.

Instructions for the outstation students.

We do not provide any hostel facility. You will have to arrange for your lodging and boarding on your own. Number of students from last year's batch have successfully done this. A list of all the outstation students will

be given to you. You may form groups and stay together by renting a suitable place.

Result of Qualifying Test Conducted on 5th April 2015

At the specific time given in the table below students in groups of 20 will be called for paying the fees. It is very important that the student or someone representing the student is present at the allotted time for finalising the admission. **In case there is no one representing the student at the allotted time, it will be assumed that the concerned student does not wish to take admission in our institute and the next student in the merit list will be offered the seat.** All the students must remain present 5 minutes before the allotted time. The admission must be finalised in the allotted time only.

Schedule for paying fees on 9th April 2015

Since we have no idea of how many students will score more than 50 percent marks, we have tentatively put a time table for 80 students. But the actual number of students called for admission may be less or more than 80. This is only a tentative time table. We will publish final time table of paying fees after declaring our results.

What is the fee for the program?

The fee for the first year is Rs. 89,888. (Rs. Eighty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Eight). This includes service tax and education cess.

For the second year exactly the same amount is to be paid in the first week of April 2016.
